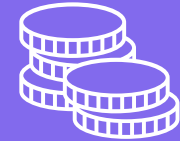

Payment options

Cash is preferred, although credit cards are also accepted in commercial areas.

What to Bring and Prepare



Your passport, evidence of sufficient funds to support your stay in PH, hotel accommodation bookings, and return tickets.

If you have a passport issued by Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, or the United States, you can enter the Philippines without a visa and stay for up to 30 days, provided:

- You are traveling to the Philippines for business or tourism.
- You have valid return or outbound tickets to your country of origin or next destination.
- Your passport is valid for at least 6 months after your planned stay in the country.

Within 72 hours before your scheduled arrival in the Philippines, please register through the eTravel portal: <https://etravel.gov.ph>.

This replaced the paper-based arrival and departure cards.



Credit card and cash. Ensure you have enough local currency (₱ - Philippine Peso) to cover your airport transfer and daily transportation from the hotel to the office and vice versa.



Prepare your itinerary ahead of time. Please communicate your plans to the Client Relationship Manager (CRM) weeks prior to your visit.



Prescriptions or over-the-counter medication, if needed.



Wall socket adapters for your gadgets as the common voltage in the Philippines is 220 volts.



Travel insurance is optional, but highly encouraged.

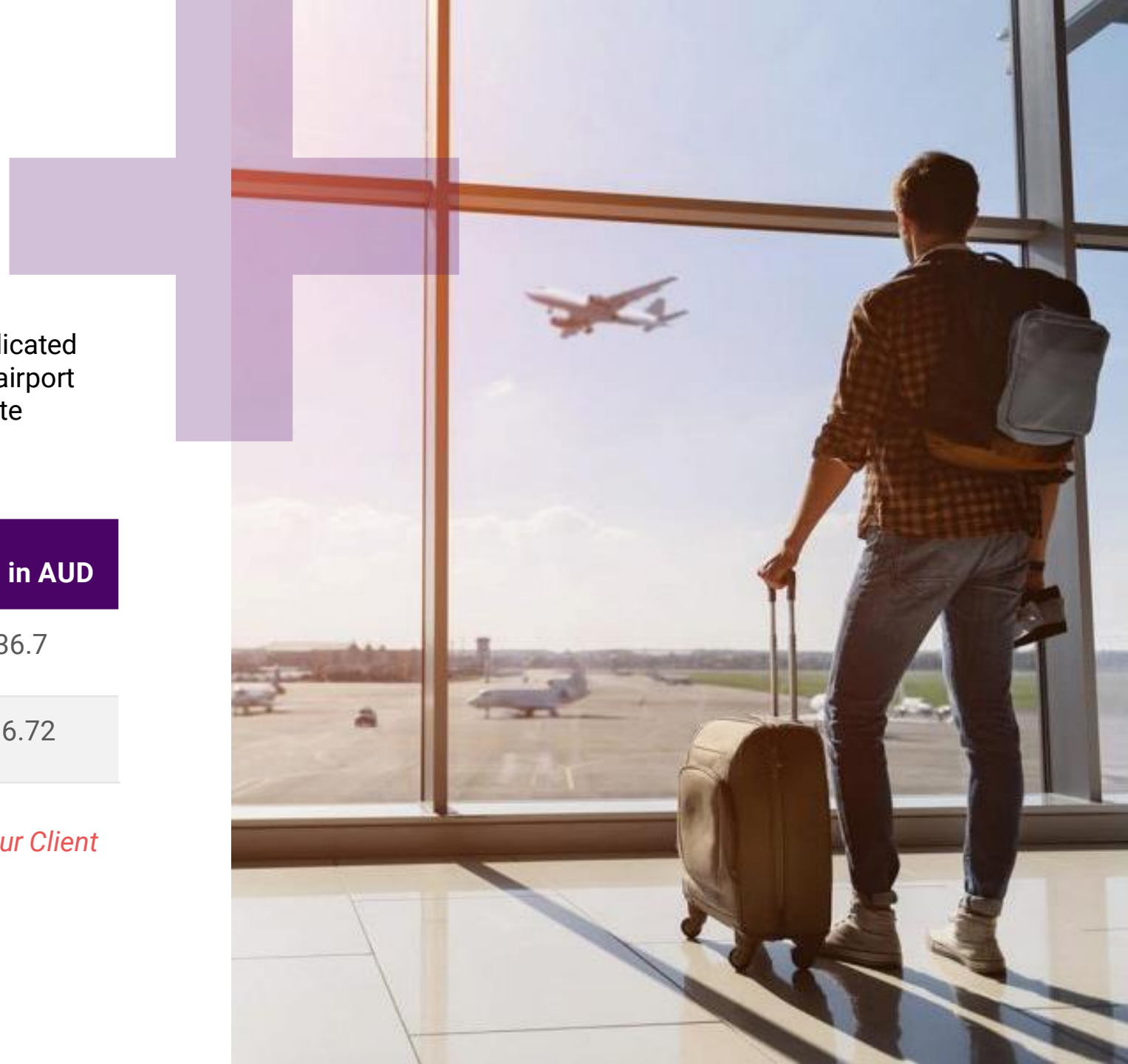

Grab Car or Grab Taxi

Blue taxi

Another option for hassle-free travel from Clark International Airport to your destination. Aside from the ₱20 booking fee, its flag down rate starts at ₱40 with additional ₱13 per additional kilometre, and ₱2 per minute of waiting time if, for instance, caught in a traffic. Use this option only if you know your way around Clark (not all regular taxi drivers use Waze).

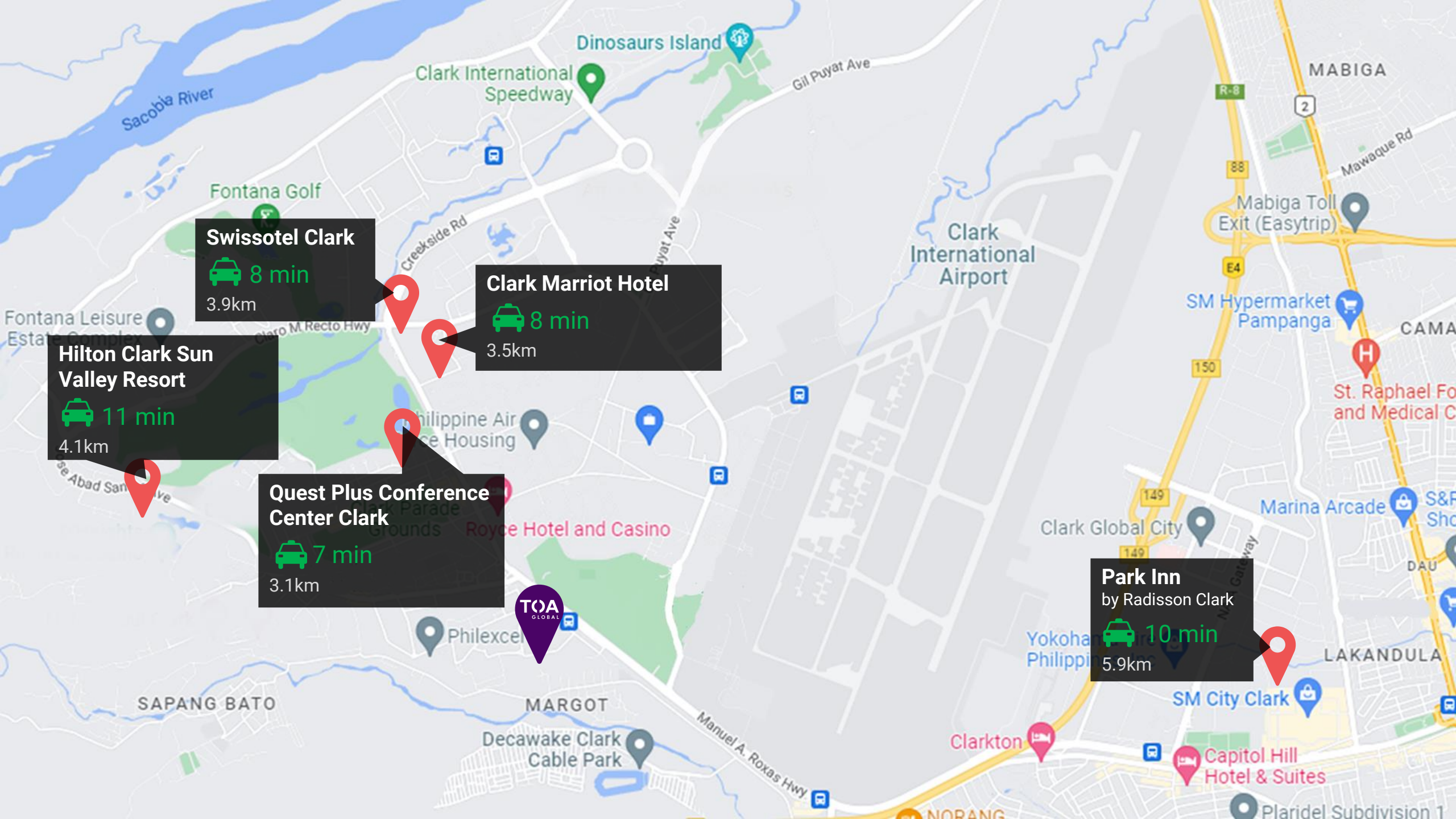
Base rate is ₱40.00 with an additional charge of ₱13.50 for every additional kilometre, and ₱2.00 for every two minutes waiting or standing in traffic.

Some drivers will also ask for “meter plus ₱50” which you can accept or wait for another vehicle.

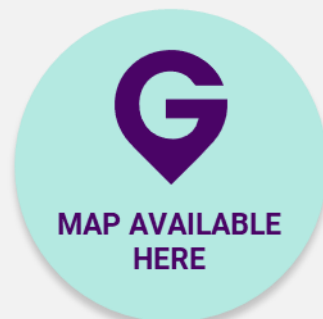

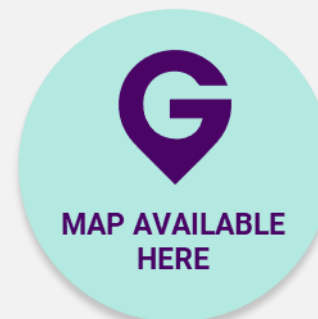

Apag Marangle

A restaurant made up of huts on stilts, with a wide fishpond underneath.

Must-try: Pork sisig (made of chopped pig's cheeks, ears, liver seasoned with calamansi and chili peppers), crispy pata (pork trotter), relyenong bangus (stuffed milkfish).

For adventurous eaters: Sizzling balut (sizzling duck embryo), betute (stuffed fried frog).



Binulo Restaurant

Best known for serving authentic Kapampangan cuisine.

Must-try: Binukadkad na hito (filleted catfish, deep-fried to perfection), sinampalukang manok (chicken soup in tamarind broth).

For adventurous eaters: Pangat na ulang (giant freshwater shrimps in a creamy, sour broth).



Matam-ih

An open-air restaurant that features indigenous arts and crafts to showcase Kapampangan heritage and culture.

Must-try: Kare-kareng iking baka (oxtail and tripe in peanut sauce), bistek kalabaw (carabao steak), sale neytib manuka tin ebun (native free-range chicken with eggs stewed in lemongrass).

For adventurous eaters: dinuguan (blood stew), chicharong bulaklak (deep-fried pork intestine).



Bale Dutung

A famous private dining, by-appointment only, space in Pampanga that serves homemade Filipino comfort food.

Must-try: Pako (fiddlehead ferns) salad, taba ng talangka (crab fat), lechon tortilla (tortilla topped with crunchy roasted pig flakes), adobong pugo (quail cooked in oil and soy sauce).

For adventurous eaters: Pinoy lumpiang ubod (a crispy spring roll served Vietnamese style with a slightly sweet and spicy Oriental sauce).





Abe's Farm

A dining destination on a farm located at the foothills of Mt Arayat.

Must-try: Adobong pusit (squid stewed in vinegar, soy sauce and squid ink), sinigang na bangus sa bayabas (stewed milkfish in guava soup), sinigang na baboy sa ube (Filipino pork soup with purple yam), sikreto ni Maria (English translation is Maria's secret; it's a dessert made of sticky rice and fresh slices of mango covered in vanilla ice cream).

For adventurous eaters: Gising gising (composed mainly of sliced water spinach stalks, meat, chili and coconut milk).



Sky Garden Café and Restaurant

A charming cafe where you can dine al fresco while enjoying the beautiful view of Mt Arayat.

Must-try: Must-try: Spicy arrabiata, steak medallion, salmon steak, black noodle with shrimp.



Smoki MOTO

Savour delicious, authentic Korean cuisine in a modern restaurant that features spectacular vibes, dramatic views and a refreshing drinks menu that includes premium wines, soju, beers and craft cocktails.

Must-try: Pan-fried dumplings and the Bulgogi vegetable hot pot.
